

Are you ready to

quit...



but prefer to do it gradually?

Quitting smoking abruptly may work for some people, but it's not right for everyone. If you want to quit but prefer to do it gradually, you may be interested in a study which is being conducted to evaluate an investigational drug that may help you to stop smoking by **reduction**.\*

If you would like to try to stop smoking by reduction you may be eligible for this study if:

- You are 18 years of age or older and are in good health,
- You have been smoking an average of 10 cigarettes or more a day for the past year, including the past month, and
- During the last year, you have been unable to quit smoking for longer than 3 months.

Qualified participants will receive study drug or placebo (inactive substance), smoking reduction and cessation counseling, and all study-related physical exams and laboratory tests at no cost.
